Henderson Business and Professional Women's Club held its regular meeting in the board room at Maria Parham Hospital on October 19th. Following a buffet dinner, there was a Presentation by Cara Gill of the Strength and Mending Child Advocacy Center. A Henderson native and graduate of UNC Wilmington, Cara worked in Alamance County prior to returning to Henderson. She has used her MSW to work with Child Protective Services and has now established her non-profit to assist local agencies with serving children who are victims of sexual or physical abuse or are witnesses of violent crimes. The Center provides a safe, non-threatening environment for interviews. A local doctor conducts medical exams as needed at the Center. The Center provides videotaped

supported analysis of victim or witness interviews and works as part of a multi-agency team serving Vance, Franklin , Granville and Warren counties to provide victim services.

A business session followed the presentation. Maria Bailey presented her afghan to be raffled off for the Club fundraiser. June Blanks will deliver tickets to members as requested. The December meeting will be held at Maria's home on December 12th at 6:00 p.m.

Henderson Business and Professional Women's Club kicked off its new program year at its regular meeting in the board room at Maria Parham Hospital on August 17th. Following a buffet dinner, Melissa Elliott, director presented a program on the history and status of Gang Free, Inc. The organization served 53 kids in a seven week summer camp. Youth and volunteers have established memorials for victims of gang violence and participated in beautification projects, educational programs, leadership development and recreational activities. The volunteer organization has developed partnerships with numerous organizations and businesses including, the United Way, Sheetz, Walmart, Food Lion, local churches, Public Safety, 4-H, Girl Scouts and the Vance County Schools. A relationship with Food Lion and NC Central Food Bank is resulting in a new kitchen for the building. As an emergency food center, Gang Free, Inc. has served over 9,000 meals this year. The Steve Harvey Show in Chicago recognized the local work with a spotlight and a \$10,000 contribution. The need for volunteers is on-going.

A brief business meeting followed the program. The Audit committee report was accepted and the membership list reviewed and updated. The meeting was adjourned with a recitation of the club collect.
