Henderson Business and Professional Women's Club took a field trip for its January 19th meeting. The club met in the conference room of the Perry Memorial Library. Following a catered meal, Patty McAnally introduced the speaker, Tem Blackburn of the Vance County Historical Museum. Mr. Blackburn presented a synopsis of Vance County's history emphasizing the interaction of the changing economic base with population growth, social fabric, financial status and sense of community. After describing the process for selection of display items, preparing sets and receiving donated treasures, he led the group on a tour of the second floor Vance County history display. As members moved about the area and browsed the timeline and artifacts, they heard thoughtful and personal background stories about items and past citizens and their contributions to their county, the state and the nation.

Following the tour the group returned to the conference room for a brief business session. Members were reminded that the next meeting would be back at the hospital and that the state WEE conference would be hosted by the BPW Foundation and would be held in Carrboro on March 25. An officer nominating committee was requested for February. The meeting was adjourned with the reading of the Collect.
